Ways of contributing to Papyrus include:

Reviews

We are interested in your opinions on a variety of things. You could review a film, a book, a restaurant /pub/ bar, a web site or even a computer game or gadget.

To write a review, give a brief description of the place/gadget/ plot of the book/film. A short paragraph is sufficient.

Then weigh the pros/cons or good/bad aspects. Try to give a balanced view.

Lastly mention your overall opinion and if you would recommend it to another.

Reviews should not exceed 100 words.

Poetry

We always welcome poetry. You can see past issues for samples.

Articles

You could take a stance on something, rant about something, write a short biography on someone you admire etc. You could alternatively write a short story.

Again a word limit of 100 words.

Grammar/Vocabulary/ Pronunciation Questions

You can submit questions for your fellow students to answer.

Riddles/ Jokes

You can submit short riddles or jokes.

Alternatively you could comment on new colloquial language you would like to see in future additions. Or suggest further columns or activities to add to our newsletter.
